# Quick Guide





### Powering Headset On and Off

- Technician to place HMD 1 on his/her head.
- Click the *power button* **2** to to turn on the HMD.
- To turn on the controller, and hold down the *home button* **3** until you feel a vibration.
- Tap the *trigger* **4** on the controller to continue.

#### Navigating the Patient Controller

• Point the controller towards the screen; a blue laser will appear. You can either use the laser or the touchpad to navigate.

## **Patient Setup**

- Prior to patient testing, clean all surfaces with sanitizing wipes. If patient has glasses, insert spherical equivalent trial lenses into the holder, remove *forehead pad* 10 in *HMD* 1, and replace with trial lens holder.
- Ensure lightshield is placed on *HMD* prior to positioning on patient's head, do not cover *sensors* **9**.
- Hand patient the controller and emphasize the location of the *bumper* 6, the only button used for testing.

**Note:** If a patient is wearing contact lenses for distance correction, they can remain on for the test.

#### **Fitting the Device**

- Using both hands, open the HMD band. 7
- Fit should be above the ears and at a 45 degree angle as shown.
- Once positioned on the patient's head, to ensure a snug fit, press gently on both sides of the headband.
- Make sure lightshield flaps are not folded down on forehead and cheek flaps are down.



#### TIPS

- At the end of the day, shut down both the controller and the device.
- To power off the HMD, click on the battery icon, then shut down.
- You will be prompted to perform a circle with your finger to confirm.

#### Creating New Patient Profile and Appointment in Heru Portal

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- A Click Patients tab.
- B Click Create Patient.
- **C** Enter patient details and click *Sαve*.
- D Within Patient Details, select New Appointment.
- E Add Physician/Technician.

F Select the Tests you'd like to apply.

- G Under the "Apply Test" section, slide the circle to the right or left to turn the test on/off for each eye.
- H Click the "Heru Guide" box to turn on the Heru guide (optional).
- Select your device from the portal's dropdown menu. (If device doesn't show up, make sure to pressthe "Let's get started" button on the Heru dashboard screen.)

#### **Exam View**

- The Fast Pattern Suprathreshold exam view.
- Monitor the progress bar 12 in the Exam View 11 to identify the percentage of test completed.



#### **Pausing the Test**

- Patient can pause the test by holding the bumper 6 on the controller for 4 seconds.
- Once the bumper is released, patient will feel a vibration.
- The fixation point will fade in and out when paused.
- To resume test, ask patient to hold down the *bumper*.
